TRANSPORTATION

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From interstate 75/85 north or south take exit #248C Freedom Parkway. Southbound travelers must merge over 4 lanes, in order to make the turn onto Boulevard. At the traffic light, turn right onto Boulevard NE. Turn left on Irwin Street. Then, turn right on Hogue Street. Next turn left on Auburn Avenue. Arrive at 39 Boulevard NE.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (MARTA)

- The #113 Auburn Avenue from the MARTA Five Points station;
- The #17 Inman Park/Lakewood from the Inman Park station on the MARTA East Rail Line; or
- The #99 King Memorial/North Avenue from the King Memorial station on the MARTA East Rail Line.
